REPRESENTATIVE MATTERS

Acted as Sole Arbitrator in a DIS arbitration between a US manufacturer against a German distributor, revolving around claims arising out of a distribution agreement for the distribution of products in several territories, including but not limited to Europe, Russia, Turkey, and Dubai (UAE), with German law as the governing law and Ludwigshafen/Rhein as the place of the arbitration.

Acted as Sole Arbitrator in an arbitration under the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules – administered by the DIS between a German licensor against a Turkish licensee, revolving around claims arising out of a web service license agreement, with German law as the governing law and Ismaning as the place of the arbitration.

Acted as Co-Arbitrator in a DIS arbitration between a German manufacturer against a Tunisian distributor in the agricultural chemicals industry, revolving around claims arising out of a distribution agreement, with German law as the governing law and Ludwigshafen/Rhein as the place of the arbitration.

Acted as Administrative Secretary in a DIS arbitration between a Scottish manufacturer against a German contractor, revolving around claims arising out of a construction contract for the planning and construction of a plant, with German law as the governing law and Munich as the place of the arbitration.
